Chemists/pharmacies can provide:

- the emergency contraceptive pill
- treatment for genital thrush
- condoms and pregnancy tests (to buy)
- needle exchange

Your doctor/Gp can provide:

- contraception including Emergency Contraception
- free condoms
- pregnancy testing, advice and referral for antenatal care/ termination of pregnancy
- cervical screening - 'smear test'
- testing and treatment for Sexually Transmitted Infections
- investigation and treatment of vaginal discharge
- testing for HIV, Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C
- Hepatitis B vaccination
- information regarding erectile dysfunction

Specialist sexual health services provide:

- contraception including emergency contraception
- condoms
- dams (reduces risk of infections from oral sex)
- longer lasting contraception e.g. implants and coils
- pregnancy testing, advice and referral for termination of pregnancy
- testing and treatment for sexually transmitted infections
- management of HIV infection
- assessment and management of genital symptoms
- hepatitis B vaccination
- safer sex advice, general advice and support for any sexually related issues or concerns
- services for members of the LGBTI Community (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender and Intersex)
